What is the CNA Conference and Trade Show (CNA2023) exactly?

CNA2023 is the premier nuclear industry event in Canada. It is three exciting days of networking with senior executives, learning from expert speakers and creating important business connections. It is a great opportunity for students interested in a career in nuclear to learn about major industry developments, future trends and career opportunities.

Am I eligible to apply?

If you are a registered student at the time of the event and currently studying at a recognized Canadian post-secondary education institution, then yes!

How do I apply?

To be selected, you must write a 250-word (max) response to the question: **Describe how nuclear energy can provide energy security for Canada in the context of the ongoing global energy crisis.** You will get extra kudos if you submit a post on either Twitter or Instagram to promote that you have applied to attend CNA2023. This will help us grow awareness among your interested peers. Please tag #CNA2023 when creating your post so we can associate your post with your application.

What is the deadline to apply for the Student Participation Program?

Applications are due by December 21, 2022, at 5:00pm EST. Applications received after this date and time will not be considered.

How do I submit my application?

Submissions will be accepted online only. Visit our CNA2023 event pages and select the "Student Program" tab on the right-hand menu to submit your application. Applications will be accepted in both English and French.

How are essays evaluated?

Your essay will be evaluated by an internal committee of CNA staff who will be looking for sound ideas and innovative responses. We love passion for the industry and the future of nuclear technology, a dash of personality and the basics of good presentation and writing skills.

Are there other selection criteria?

Yes. Our final selections will be submitted to the Deans and Administrators of your academic institution to confirm your eligibility to attend. Your school may elect to restrict you from attending if you are not a student in good standing, or for any other reason they deem important.

When will winners be notified?

The winners will be notified by January 4, 2023. Students not selected will still be eligible to register at the regular student rate of \$405.
